"Briseida came to our children's home during her last year and half of elementary school. Her life had been so unstable that she had intermittently attended school, missing months of classes each year. Our first meeting in my office was unforgettable. We sat down to figure out what grade level she should be in. She spoke confidently and politely and assured me that she knew how to read. But as we worked together, every response that she gave me was incoherent. As she answered comprehension questions about the story we read, her answers had nothing to do with the story we were reading. Her math calculations had no semblance to any solutions I had ever seen. It seemed that everything she produced made no sense at all.

We have had the privilege of working with Briseida for several years now, and she has received the gift of consistent, faith-based education in a small classroom where she can get the attention she needs. Briseida is now at the top of her 8th-grade class. She has blossomed in reading and writing and is excellent at problem-solving. She is currently studying algebra and is perfectly capable of learning the new concepts that she encounters.

Briseida's future has changed. She will have the possibility to go to university one day if she wants. She can break the cycle of poverty in her family by choosing a career. A world of possibilities has opened to her because she has been able to go to school and truly learn."

They came to Baja in hopes of finding work in the fields to provide for their children. The parents are very responsible and good about getting their children to us almost every day. They work every day and take one day off so they can be with their children.

I remember when the dad first came and looked at the places, he said, "there should be more places like this and people like you that help families – I want my kids here." It makes me so happy that the children can be here and have time to be a family. The dad told me that they can now provide things for their kids, spend quality time together, and get something like ice cream - the ability to show them love.

This is just one small example of many at the Daycare - how lives are being impacted. Not just for the kids, but for the parents too. In October, we celebrated 3 years open - and this family and many others have been blessed. This makes my heart so happy, and I know that the Lord is in this."
