

HIS MINISTRY Prayer: Our Foundation

From the beginning of FFHM, prayer has been the foundation. This ministry started with a small group of people who would gather weekly to pray for missions, in the 1960's. Since the ministry has grown immensely over the years, from one location in Mexico to multiple locations, it is more difficult to be "united" in prayer. A few years ago we felt the need to come together and lift up each specific area of His Ministry. This led us to start our annual "month of prayer" in 2021. At each location in Mexico, we dedicated the month and our corporate devotion times to praying for the different areas of the ministry. We invited others to join us as we sent out a prayer calendar to all of our supporters, so that together we could intentionally pray. Each year, it has been amazing to see how God has responded to our prayers and we have celebrated together the ways that we saw Him at work.

I learned firsthand the importance of prayer while living at our Oaxaca Mis-


















sion. The month of October was always spiritually dark. The Day of the Dead was celebrated at the end of the month, and it was complicated in Oaxaca – it included witchcraft and even animal sacrifices. So, we would set aside that month to be intentional about prayer and fasting and to ask for God's protection over every aspect of the ministry.

One year, during this prayer time, a neighbor came with a vision she had received while praying for us. She said that as a warning, God showed her a picture of our children running down the driveway covered in blood. We started praying specifically against that vision and asking God to protect our children physically.

A few days later, as I was setting the table for lunch in the dining hall, one of the children ran in to tell me that they were on their way back from school and had almost arrived at the mission when they were in a car accident. A taxi had t-boned the 15-passenger van they were traveling in. I ran out out of the dining hall to see how I could help and was startled to see the children running down the driveway. I immediately thought of our neighbor's vision, but the difference was that none of the kids were bleeding. Even though the taxi hit them at a high speed, none of the children were seriously injured. God had protected us, and we had experienced a miracle!

So, I often think of that time in October when we dedicated the month to seeking God and praying. And I know that He will reveal himself and provide once again. May you experience God in new ways as you join us in praying this month!
