Today I was reading Acts 1 and was struck by verse 14 where it says, speaking of the apostles, "They all joined together constantly in prayer." This phrase reminded me of how this ministry was birthed out of a prayer group that would join every Friday to pray for missions. And we want the ministry to continue to be characterized as "people who join together constantly in prayer."

In some ways, the fall feels like the beginning of the new year for us. Kids go back to school, we write goals for the coming year, and our fiscal year ends,

so it is a reset of budgets. Because of this, last year, we decided to do our first month of prayer in September. We quickly decided this would be an annual event. We sent out calendars to each mission location and those who received the newsletter with specific ways they could be praying each day. We then ended the month by having a day of prayer and fasting with everyone at each location.

Sara Petersen, the Baja Mission Director, told us this time was a highlight of the year. She said they were coming out of Covid and spiritually in a stagnant place. The month of prayer brought some revival to the mission and changed the prayer dynamic within the ministry. Prayer became a good habit and something they look forward to. They also saw immediate answers to prayer and fruit from that time that allowed them to experience healing and bring focus to different areas they weren't aware of before the month.

We also experienced miracles in Tijuana. For nine months, we had been waiting fully staffed with a renovated building to be able to begin receiving teenage girls from the government shelter. But the government was dragging its feet on completing our certification for various reasons. So that was one of the things we were praying specifically for during the month. Then the day after our time of prayer and fasting, we received a call from the government asking if we would be willing to accept eight girls. We knew this was a direct answer to prayer and fruit from that time we had spent together asking God to act.

And so, we are doing another month of prayer this September. Inside this newsletter, you will find a calendar showing focused ways you can join us all in Mexico praying for the ministry. On September 30th, there will be another day of prayer and fasting. We will host this on Facebook so that anyone interested can join us. So be checking our page there so you can be a part of this day and experience firsthand how we know God will answer our prayers.
